INDIVIDUAL PLAN OF EDUCATION FOR A GIVEN SEMESTER

Individual plan of education is prepared in accordance with § 4 para. 10, par. 11, par. 23 and § 5 para. 6, par. 7 of the Doctoral School Regulations. As part of interdisciplinary education, it should also include courses (lectures and seminars) from the above list, conducted for example: for other disciplines, or

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by visiting professors, or in the form of on-line courses offered by other universities, including foreign ones. They can also be lectures or seminars held during a scientific internship at a domestic or foreign research institution.

APPRENTICESHIPS

Apprenticeships are implemented by conducting classes at the University by a PhD student or participating in the conduct. 60 hours every academic year, total of 240 hours. In accordance with § 4 para. 14 – para. 16 of the Doctoral School Regulations.

INDIVIDUAL RESEARCH PLAN

Each PhD student prepares the individual research plan in accordance with § 5 para. 4 – para. 6 of the Doctoral School Regulations in agreement with the supervisors or supervisors, taking into account at least all learning outcomes achieved, which are not included in the table on page 1 and presented to the Doctoral School Dean within 12 months from the day of starting education. In the case of appointing an auxiliary supervisor, the individual research plan is presented after giving her/his opinion.

ACHIEVING LEARNING OUTCOMES FOR QUALIFICATION AT LEVEL 8 OF POLISH QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK (PQF) REQUIRES:

implementing a total of 390 hours of courses covered by the program with a total value of 33 ETCS points, apprenticeships, completion of an individual research plan concluded with the submission of a doctoral dissertation, while learning outcomes in English must be confirmed by a certificate issued by the Foreign Languages Department (SJO) of Wrocław University of Science and Technology certifying knowledge of this language at least the B2 level of language proficiency.
