EIT Jumpstarter is an award-winning pan-European pre-accelerator programme for innovators in eight thematic fields: Digital, Food, Health, Innoenergy, Manufacturing, New European Bauhaus, Raw Materials and Urban Mobility.

The New European Bauhaus category of the EIT Jumpstarter programme contributes to boosting innovation and entrepreneurship within Central-Eastern and Southern Europe by validating innovative solutions which break down boundaries between science and technology, art, culture and social inclusion. It is ideal for teams with innovative solutions to societal problems and sustainability, aesthetics and inclusion. With the contribution of the best-in-class experts, creative community, and unique



know-how, we aim to support idea-holders to turn their ideas into business. We help them build a viable business model around their innovative product or service idea, validate it, and encourage them to register their company if it is sustainable. In 2019, EIT Jumpstarter won the Best Association Training Initiative Award of the European Association Awards.

We are looking for innovative solutions that contribute to developing beautiful, sustainable and inclusive places, products and ways of living. The ideas should connect the objectives of the European Green Deal to the daily life of European citizens. In their proposals, applicants should pay particular attention to at least one of the three dimensions of the New European Bauhaus:

Sustainability: e.g. ecosystem conservation, waste management, heat waves mitigation, exploiting the farming potential of block facades, decreasing CO2 level, preserving biodiversity, mitigating climate change, fostering circularity

Aesthetics: when functionality and style/art go together, e.g., promotion of local culture and music, creative services suited to researchers and scientists, bringing and feel nature indoors, making healthy eating visually attractive, transforming public buildings and spaces more sustainable



Inclusion: securing accessibility and affordability to all, e.g., collaborative food growing, diversifying neighbourhoods, the wellbeing of users in buildings, connecting seniors/pensioners, and cross-generation exchange.
